What Is Tunes from the Tombs?

Now in its ninth year, Tunes from the Tombs is a great way to explore Atlanta history while enjoying music and performances at one of the city's most unique music venues. Take in the sights and sounds under Oakland's ancient magnolias, visit some of Oakland's famous residents, and find one-of-a-kind souvenirs at the artist market. All proceeds from Tunes from the Tombs benefit HOF's mission to preserve, restore, enhance, and share Historic Oakland Cemetery.

Tunes from the Tombs will take place on Saturday, June 8 from noon to 8 p.m., with gates opening at noon and performances beginning at 12:30 p.m.

Where can I park?

Unlike in previous years, we do not have use of the King Memorial MARTA Station parking lot.

Limited off-street parking is available on Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive and surrounding streets. We encourage attendees to walk, bike, car share, or use public transportation to get to Tunes from the Tombs. Oakland Cemetery is a short walk from the King Memorial MARTA Station.

Do I need to purchase a ticket in advance?

Because Oakland Cemetery is a venue with limited capacity, advance ticketing is strongly recommended. Advance tickets are available online at [Freshtix.com](https://www.freshtix.com).

Adult tickets are \$20 in advance and \$25 at the gate. Tickets for seniors and students are \$15 in advance and \$20 at the gate. Tickets for children aged 4-17 are \$10 in advance and \$15 at the gate. (all prices are plus taxes and fees). Children 3 and under are free.

Rock In Peace (R.I.P.) packages must be purchased in advance, online only. R.I.P. packages are \$75 for adults (plus taxes and fees). R.I.P. ticketholders receive:

- Private V.I.P. area next to the MailChimp Mainstage including restroom
- Three drink vouchers for beer, wine, cocktails, or soft drinks
- Tunes from the Tombs 2019 T-shirt and HOF Koozie
- Free parking
- VIP shuttle throughout the Cemetery. Shuttle pickup is at the Bell Tower, Platform Main Stage at Potter's Field, the New Realm Beer Garden Stage at Lion Square, and the Larkin Underground Stage at North Public Grounds.

Will Oakland Cemetery host any tours during Tunes from the Tombs?

The “Sights, Symbols & Stories” guided overview tour and special topic tours will not be offered on Saturday, June 8. However, during Tunes from the Tombs attendees can enjoy 30-minute mini guided tours offered throughout the day:

Tunes from the Tombs mini tours:

- Sights, Symbols & Stories of Oakland
- Art & Architecture of Death
- Malts and Vaults: Where Beer Meets History
- The Women of Oakland
- History, Mystery, & Mayhem

All tours leave from the Out in the Rain fountain. Oakland Cemetery’s regular tour schedule will resume on Sunday, June 9.

Is Tunes from the Tombs dog-friendly?

No. With the exception of service animals, dogs and other pets are not permitted at Tunes from the Tombs in accordance with our City of Atlanta event permit.

What else is there to do at Tunes from the Tombs?

Tunes from the Tombs features fortune teller Victoria Rose located in the Rawson Mausoleum, living statuary Bob Seymore, King of Pops Field Day on Potter’s Field, and an Oakland Cemetery pop-up shop and artist market featuring local creatives.

Will there be food and drink?

It’s not a festival without food and drink, and we’ll have plenty of both at Tunes from the Tombs! Beer, wine, and soft drinks will be available for purchase throughout the cemetery. No coolers, outside food or drink are permitted.

Is Tunes from the Tombs cash only?

No. Credit or debit card payments are accepted at Tunes from the Tombs.

What if it rains?

Tunes from the Tombs is a rain-or-shine event, and no refunds will be issued for advance ticketing.

Where do I get my Tunes from the Tombs t-shirt?

R.I.P. ticketholders will receive their 2019 Tunes from the Tombs t-shirt at the Oakland Cemetery pop-up shop.

General admission ticketholders can also purchase t-shirts at the Oakland Cemetery pop-up shop located at the artists market.

Can I bring my own chair to Tunes from the Tombs?

Blankets and low-backed chairs are permitted. No coolers, outside food or drink permitted.
